There is something extremely important I want you to begin praying about. I want you to begin praying that you would do God's Will.

“But Pastor? Isn't living a Christian Life doing God's Will?” The answer to that question depends greatly on what someone means by living a Christian Life.

Prayer, Bible Study, Fellowship in a local Body. All of those things are important, but if we are to be actual followers of Christ we must do the things Jesus did. And Jesus reached out to lost people.

I find it amazing that many believers today seek the miraculous with all the faith they can muster, and when “signs and wonders” appear they believe their faith to be rewarded, and affirm to themselves their own discipleship.

It's wrong. Furthermore, it isn't a sign of God's glory let alone His approval. Signs and wonders were meant to confirm the preaching of the Gospel. Jesus called generations that seek signs and wonders wicked. Yet, it is easier in their minds to build enough faith to heal the sick than it is to speak to the lost.

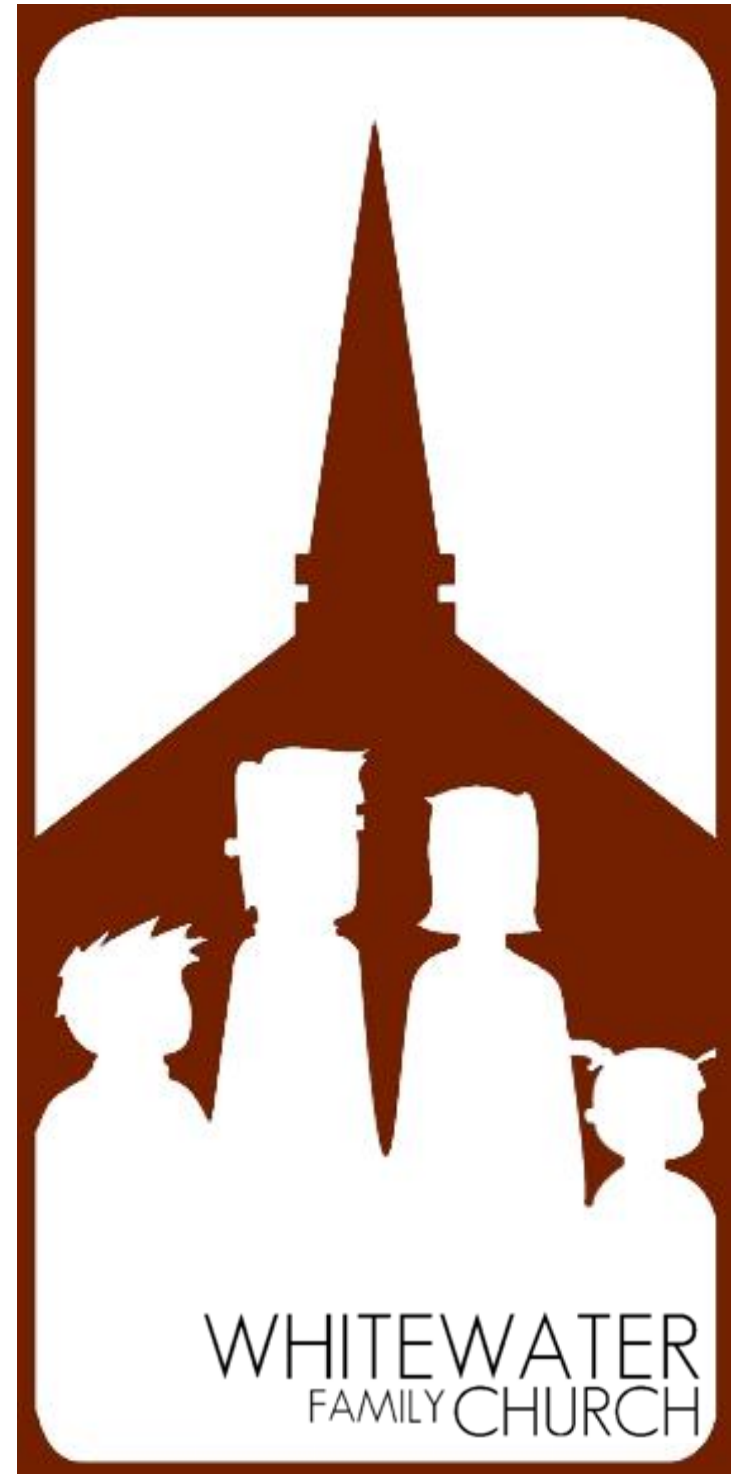
