

Thoughts from Pastor – A Sermon Companion

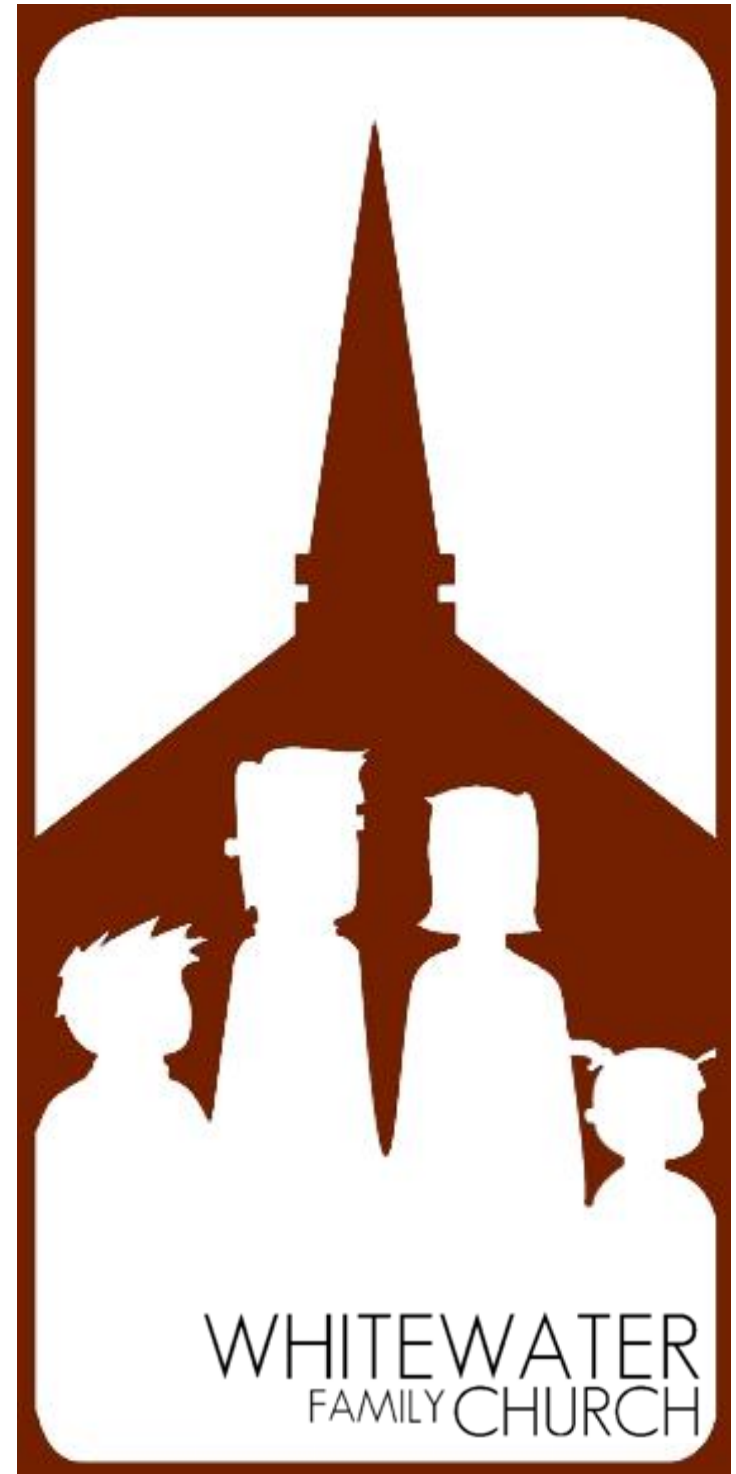
The Resurrection of Jesus Christ is the most impacting event of human history. It altered the state of the entire world. It has changed the course of societies and caused the rise and fall of nations. Other events have made an impact on their time, but none have stretched so far or reached so thoroughly through the hearts of men as the risen Christ.

Yet it is not in the ebb and flow of the nations that interests God but in the hearts of people. He does desire to change the world, but through us. The resurrection was meant to make an impact on individuals.
